## I can visit the library:

**Monday: 8 AM - 4 PM**  
**Tuesday: 8 AM - 4 PM**  
**Wednesday: 8 AM - 6 PM**  
**Thursday: 8 AM - 6 PM**  
**Friday: 7 AM - 3 PM**  
**Saturday: 8 AM - 12 AM**

## In July and August I can visit the library at this time:

**Monday: 8 AM - 3 PM**  
**Tuesday: 8 AM - 34 PM**  
**Wednesday: 8 AM - 6 PM**  
**Thursday: 8 AM - 3 PM**  
**Friday: 7 AM - 1 PM**



**The parking lot is next to the building.**

**Parking spaces with a blue line are free for 90 minutes and parking spaces with white lines are free.**

**If I'm using the blue zone parking space I need to show the time of arrival with a parking clock or a piece of paper with time of arrival that I put on a visible spot in my car.**



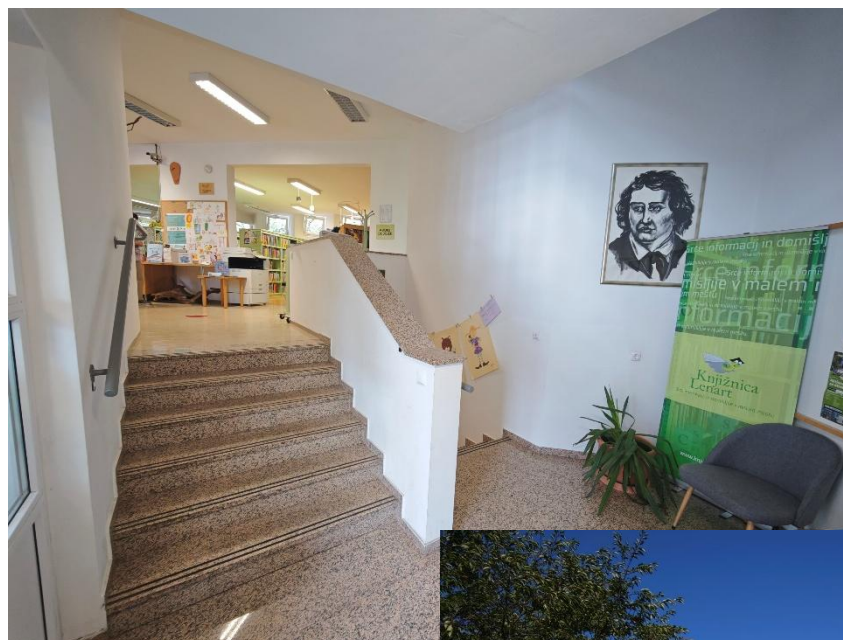
**Here is the

**I ring the bell and a librarian will open the door for me.**

**Using this reader's card, I will be able to borrow books from the library.**



**The children's department has books, magazines, toys, board games, coloring pages and coloring pencils. It's located on the first floor across from the Reception.**



**Next to the children's department is the youth department with a lot of interesting books, comics and magazines for children and young people from ages 9 to 19.**



**This is where I can borrow books.  
The shelves are green or brown. Some books are also displayed  
on small tables.  
Don't worry, you can borrow all of them.**



**This is where I can borrow magazines.**

**If I look closely I can find magazines for children and young adults among them.**



**If the library is closed  
and I want to return  
the books I borrowed  
I can use the return  
box next to the main  
entrance.**



**If I have to use the toilet I can ask the librarian for the key. The key opens the glass door downstairs. The toilets are just behind the glass doors.**



**If I can't walk down the stairs the toilets are accessible by a ramp behind the library**

**The door at the end of the ramp opens up to the big room (the auditorium).**

**On the other side of the room I find the door that leads to the hallway.**

**At the end of the hallway on the left hand side I will find the toilets.**

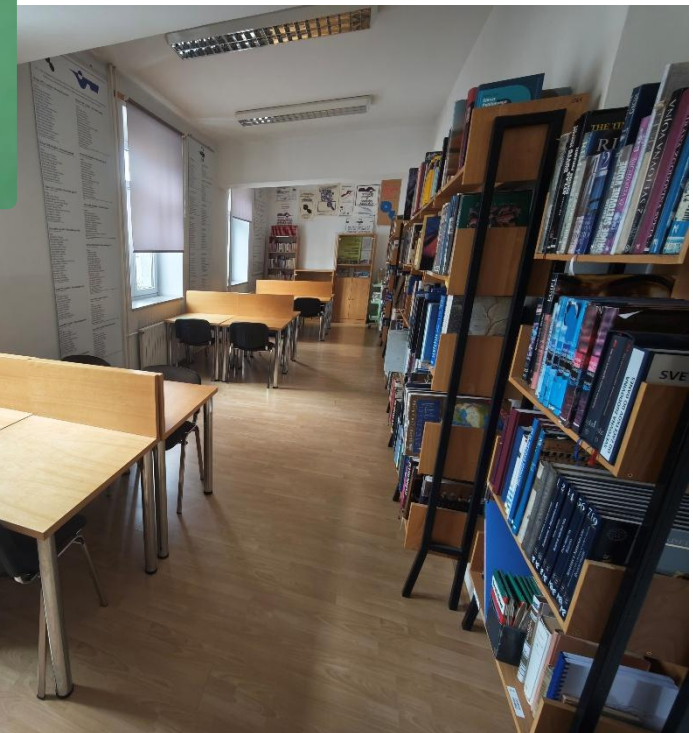


**Downstairs is also located a room especially ment for children named Storytelling room.**

**In this room we gather every other Wednesday to listen to stories and do arts and crafts.**



**The library can be very noisy at times. If this happens, I can talk to a librarian, go to a quieter place, and use noise-canceling headphones.**



**The quieter room of the library is called ČITALNICA. You can find it on the first floor.**

I came in.**

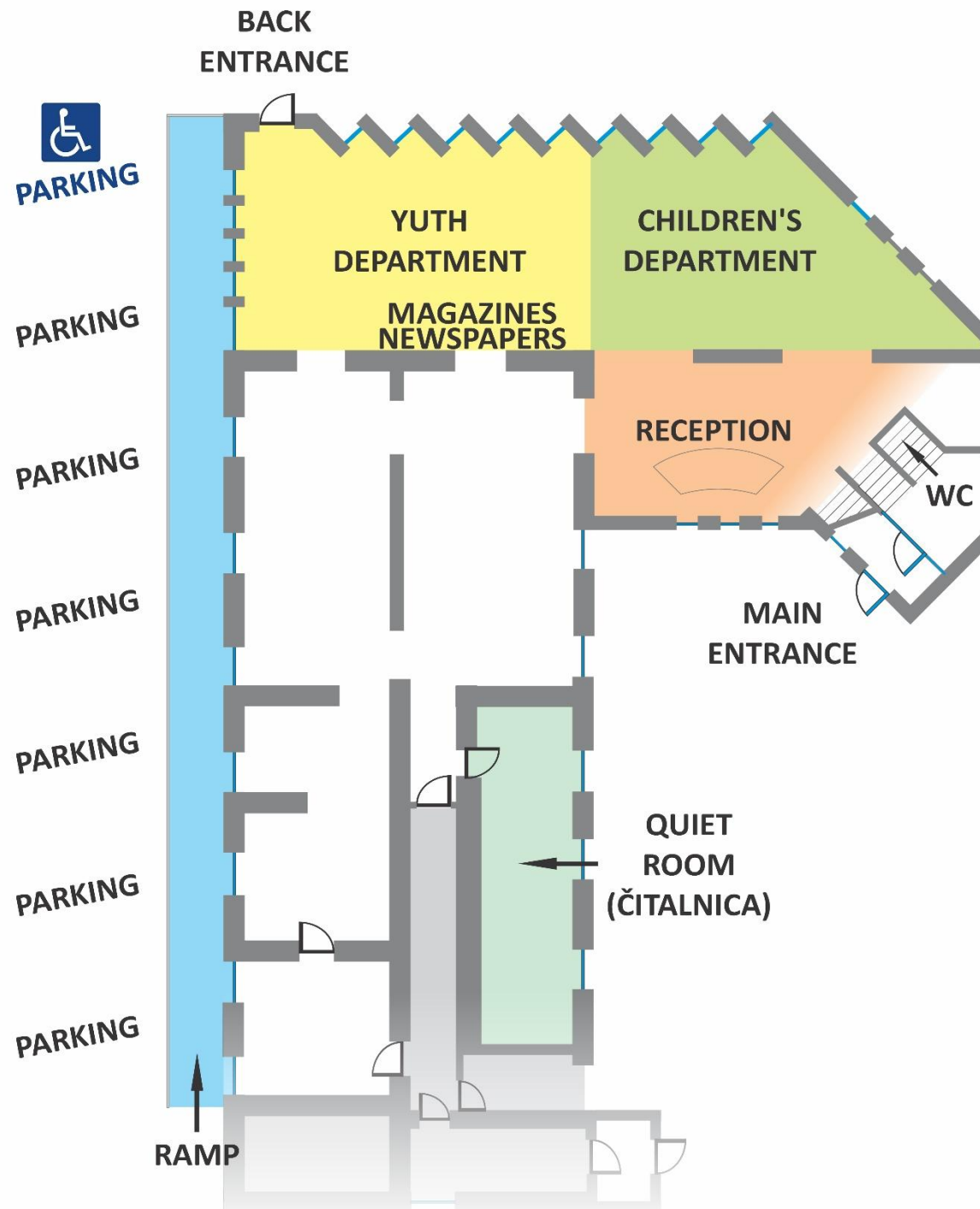
**This is the main  
entrance/exit.**

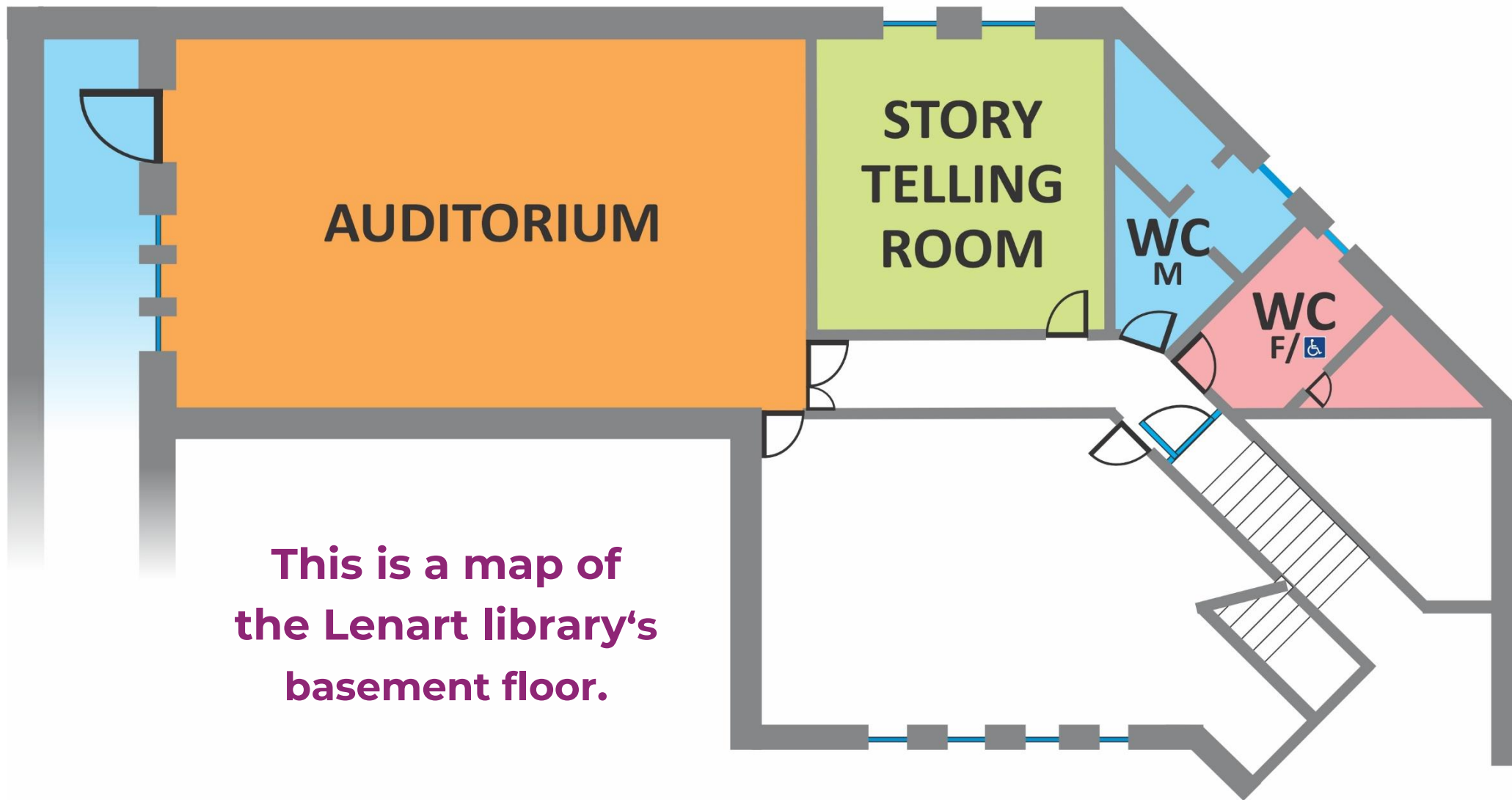


**If I came in through
